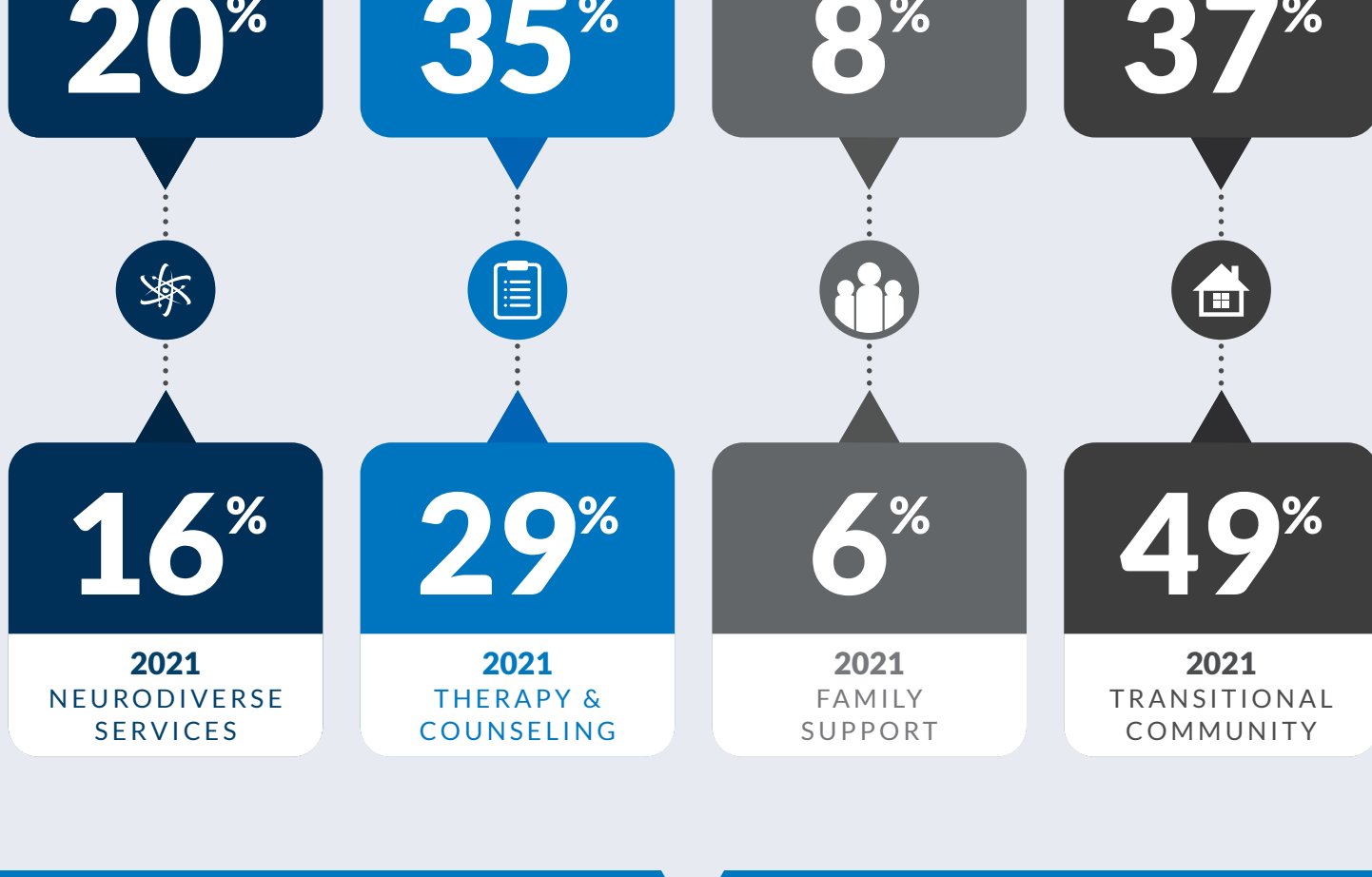

NEW PROGRAM STEPPING STONES

Ryther's Transitional Youth Services (TYS) created the Stepping Stones program to help youth and young adults who are experiencing homelessness and/or unstably housed and have also been diagnosed with Intellectual or Development Disabilities. Participants will collaborate with our staff, focusing on working towards a pathway to stability. Goals may include, but are not limited to, getting into stable housing, connecting with healthcare providers or a peer partner, or linking with long-term benefits.

Stepping Stones is a program to enhance services within the TYS program. It aims to change the trajectory for youth with disabilities who commonly age out of youth services into the adult homeless system between the ages of 13-25.

PROGRAM SUCCESS HEALTH HOMES

The Health Homes Program provides care coordination and service linkages for Medicaid covered families that have a child with a significant physical health care concern as well as a possible behavioral health care issue. Ryther's Health Home staff assist these families in navigating the health care arenas in which they are involved, as well as helping them to access the support and ancillary services they need for their child or family resulting from their child's illness.

A young female client with sickle-cell anemia enrolled in the program while in the ER with sickle-cell symptoms often triggered by cold weather. During this time, her family was struggling with homelessness and living in their car. Health Homes helped in a variety of ways, by connecting the client with a primary care doctor for preventative care, medical resources such as free eyeglasses, signing up for food stamps, purchasing groceries, and helping her mother enroll in classes to learn English.

The client and her family are no longer in crisis. Health Homes has helped them to utilize natural support and to find a supportive community member to stay with. Now that their basic needs are being met, it is easier for her to look towards her long-term goals. She is a strong student and has received a full scholarship to her dream school next year, which is a big success for this family!

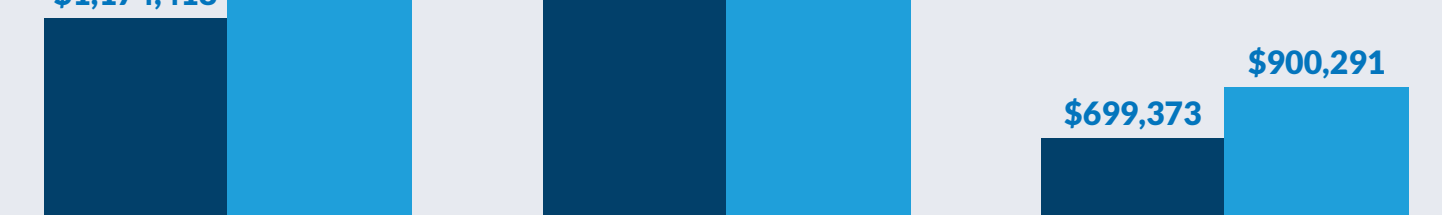
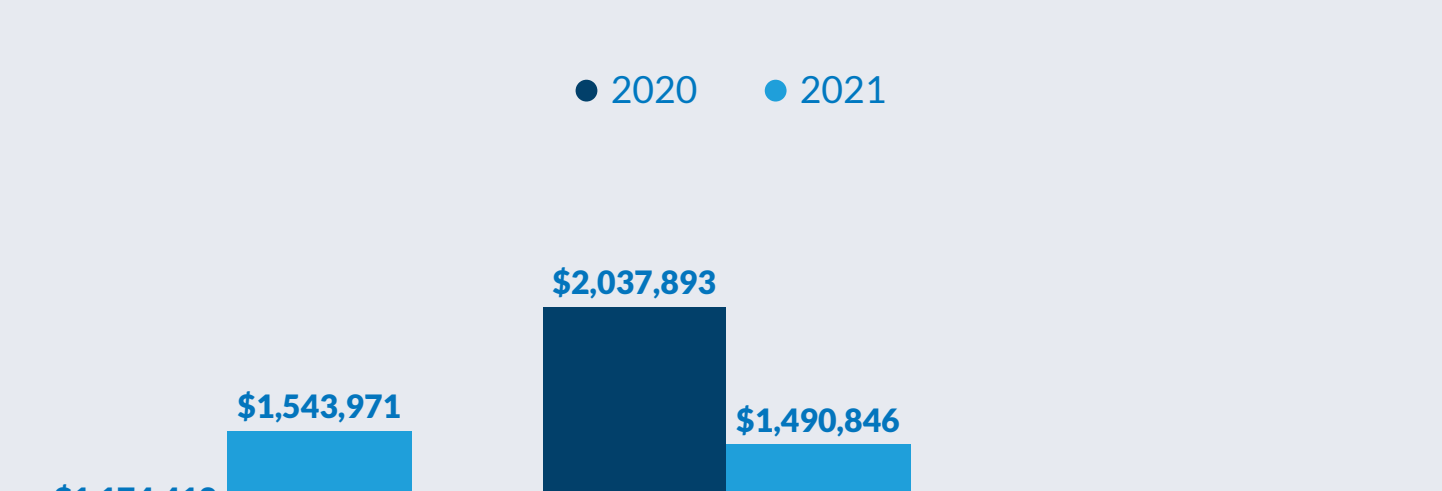
